Mesecheues is a medium to large tree that grows in the understory of the primary forest in Babeldaob. Specimens were collected in Ngatpang, Ngchesar, and in the



Rock Islands. It's a small tree that grows 2 to 6 m in height. Rusty brown hair-like scales cover the branches, leaves and inflorescence.
