

Palauan Name: Ngmui

Scientific Name: *Stemonurus ammui*

Family Name: Icacinaceae



Ngmui is found in freshwater swamp forest adjacent to the mangrove

on the west coast of Babeldaob. It is a large tree that grows up to 25 m in height and has looping knee-like aerial roots called pneumatophores. The wood from older trees is termite, sun and water resistant and is excellent for posts, floors and general house construction.
